Dear Flyway Festival Exhibitor and Sponsor:

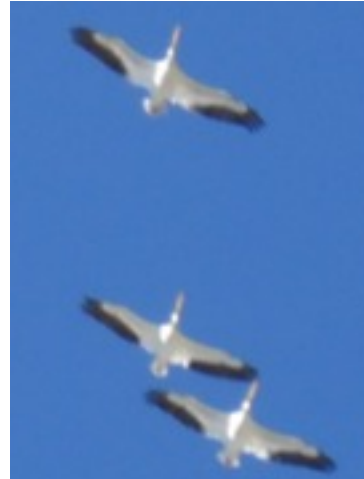
Greetings once again, from Mare Island. I am proud to invite you to exhibit and present at and sponsor our **San Francisco Bay Flyway Festival February 11-13, 2011**. Like me, I imagine that you are drawn outdoors particularly at this time of year because all around you, whether from

its unique assemblage of historic, natural and scenic features, it instantly takes us back to other eras. I experience a certain curiosity and sense of place that fills me with joy and awe as I cross the Napa River onto the island.

Early on a Saturday morning a few weeks ago as I crossed the blue bridge, four white geese or were they swans, flew

upriver. (I'm just not a birder, yet) A few minutes later, as I arrived at the Shoreline Heritage Preserve, a red-tailed hawk so pale that I might have

mistaken it for an osprey earlier in the season, circled low and landed high above me on a lightning rod before hunting for a time over the nearby field. Later in the day as we gathered in the quiet of the Navy's oldest cemetery in the Pacific, with the only sounds the chanting and singing of four Russian Orthodox priests remembering and blessing the 8 Russian sailors buried there nearly 150 years ago. When the call of a red-shouldered hawk pierced through the ancient chants, songs and ringing bells. I thought to myself, "This is



just the kind of day our Flyway Festival guests have come to expect each winter here on the island." I hope you will join us again this year and help ensure another great celebration and gathering of people as passionate about birds, wildlife, nature, history and recreation as you and I are.

Flyway Festival on the move

As magical as Mare Island is, it has been a tremendous challenge to hold the *Flyway Festival* here each year and this year is no different. Given that we had quite a struggle last year with the last minute work of copper thieves that threatened to keep us in the dark, we have been forced to reconsider where we should hold the event. I have considered moving to another town, but am committed to trying to keep the *Flyway Festival* on Mare Island. We have grown quite fond of our Wildlife Expo headquarters location for the past 9 years, but it appears that we are going

somewhere new. I'm excited to report that for this year, we will gather in **Building 223 near the center of the Island** and close to our new Wildlife Walking Trail. I wish I could say that we have a permanent home, but that doesn't seem to be the way things are here at Mare Island: change seems more the norm.

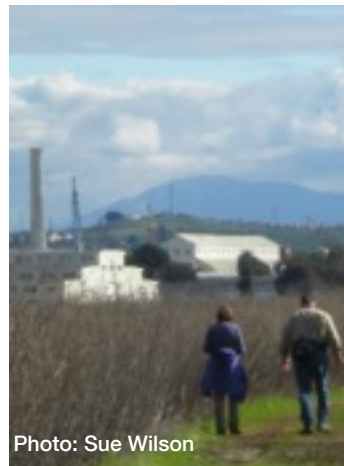

Many tours leave directly from the indoor Wildlife Expo. **Saturday and Sunday hours at the Expo run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.**

DEADLINES: The last day to reserve space is Friday, February 4, 2011. You are encouraged to submit your application as soon as possible and no later than January 18, 2011 for outings and presentations to be included in the schedule. Late applicants cannot be guaranteed maximum publicity.

BANNERS & SIGNAGE: You may hang your banner on your table or behind your table on framework. Sponsors receive additional opportunities.

WEATHER: The event happens **Rain or Shine!**

SET UP ACCESS: You may set up your display Friday, February 11, between 2pm and 5pm, or on Saturday, February 12, or Sunday, February 13 after 7am. All exhibits and displays must be complete by 8:45am Saturday or Sunday.

EXHIBITOR PARKING: We want to allow the public the closest parking, so please bring wagons, or wheelies, for transporting your displays from your

vehicle to the building. All exhibitor vehicles MUST be moved from the entry area and adjacent parking spaces, by 9am.

TAKE DOWN: All materials and displays must be removed following the close of the event Saturday at 4pm, or after the close of the event Sunday at 4pm. Tear down will not be permitted during Festival hours for liability reasons.

FOOD & DRINK: We will again offer hot drinks, teas, juices, pastries, muffins, soup, hot dogs, sodas, fruit and other casual lunch fare for reasonable prices.

ABOUT THE EXPO SPACE: The space will be indoors with ample parking and wheel chair access. Portable restrooms, limited water and full electricity are available, but heat is difficult. Please dress in layers for warmth. Lighting is mostly natural light with fluorescent.
